If your child is unwell...

Medical Leave (ML)

- Students who are unwell / Ag+, are to see a doctor and rest at home.
- Inform the Form Teachers via Remind App.
- To submit the Medical Certificate to the Form Teacher when the child returns to school.

Injuries/Illnesses that Require Medical Attention

- If your child sustained minor injury in the school, a first aid trained staff will attend to your child. We will contact you if we assessed that further medical attention is needed for your child's injury.
- Parents/guardian must sign your child out at the Guard Post (front gate) before bringing your child home.
- In an unlikely case of an emergency, an ambulance will be called. Parents will be informed that an ambulance was called and will meet their child at the hospital.

Food Safety

The school <u>will not be allowing individual</u> <u>birthday celebrations</u> in class or at the canteen where food is involved. This includes giving out of goodie bags.

TRANSITION TO PRIMARY 1


When your child enters primary school, they will experience:




